Preamble:

There is a need to review the By-Laws of the corporation to ensure that they continue to meet government requirements and the strategic plan, goals and the desired operations of the voting membership of Cricket Canada.

1. Policy Statement

1.1 In order to ensure the by-laws are up to date as needed by Cricket Canada, the Board will review the By-Laws annually. The Executive Director/ General Manager will be responsible for informing the Board whenever there are changes in the government By-Law requirements.

2. Review Process

2.1 The Board will create a By-Law review committee every year. The By-Law review committee will be composed of individuals drawn from Cricket Canada's participants and may involve outside consultation.

2.2 The Board will present any recommended By-Law changes to the membership in accordance with the current By-Laws of the corporation

2.3 By law review shall be a mandatory item in the AGM. Where no changes are to be put forward for the review and approval of the membership, it will be recorded as such.

3. Review and Approval

3.1 The Cricket Canada Board of Directors shall review the policy biennially.
