- *Name Change & Incorporation as Cricket Ontario (Formerly Cricket Council of Ontario).*

*February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018: Cricket Ontario was officially recognized as the Provincial Sports Organization (PSO) for the province of Ontario.*

*Excerpt of the official recognition letter ...' As a result, it is my pleasure to inform you that Cricket Ontario has now achieved "full recognition" as the Provincial Sport Organization for cricket in Ontario. With full recognition, your organization is eligible to apply to Ministry funding programs.'*

*Cricket Ontario relaunched its annual interleague competition in conjunction with Cricket Canada Central T20 Competition with the inclusion of Manitoba & Quebec along with Six (6) Ontario Teams from the various member leagues of Cricket Ontario.*

- *As was the objectives – it brought to light the quality of Cricket that is being played in all part of Ontario – such as Ottawa, Scarborough, Northern & Southern Ontario – as well as all other Leagues in Central Ontario that were official members of Cricket Ontario.*

- *2017 Canada Cup*

*Unfortunately – U17 Canada Cup was cancelled and will be played in 2018 – which was a disappointment to the scores of kids who went through the registration, trials & selection processes to be in a position to be selected for the provincial two (2) teams and to get the opportunity of playing against their peers from the other provinces – and event that they eagerly await to participate in for that last few years – as in 2014, 2016 & 2016 consecutively.*

- *Canada – National U19 Team (Training & Preparation) – ICC Americas Competition & the ICC U19 WC*

*Cricket Ontario played a substantial part in the training, development and conditioning of these players in preparation for both the ICC Americas (which was won by Canada) as well as the ICC WC competitions.*

*Seeing that most of the players were from Ontario – Cricket Ontario coaches & officials did their best in volunteering – as assigned by Cricket Canada – to ensure a continual skills & development program – as well as a fitness program in place.*

*This was also made available to the players from the other provinces – who were brought in at specific times to join the group and benefit from the programs in place.*

*Cricket Ontario in joint partnership with Cricket Canada also participated in organizing and ensuring that all local games were well executed and were successful in presenting the opportunities for the Team to get real time game experience.*
